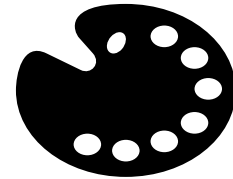
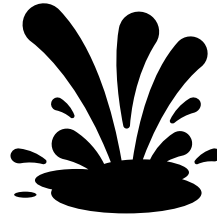

- Open to Kindergarten thru 12<sup>th</sup> Grade students in the Big Bear Lake area, including: Big Bear Lake, Big Bear City, Erwin Lake, Fawnskin, Sugarloaf, Moonridge, Baldwin Lake, and Lake William residents. One entry per student/child.
- Posters must be submitted on 8.5x11 or 11x17 paper (can be provided upon request).
- Various medias accepted including but not limited to: Crayon, marker, pencil, paint, pastel, cut paper, fabric, etc. Limited to 2-D submissions please. Be creative!
- Submissions must reflect the student's own ability. Any copyrighted images or characters will not be eligible for a prize.
- **Entries due October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020!** Winners will be selected in Mid October and contacted by e-mail.
- One Grand Prize winner, three Runner-Ups, and one Honorable Mention may be selected for each Category: Elementary School, Middle School, and High School (Up to 15 prizes to be awarded). Total number of winners may be adjusted based on number of entries.
